GRADUATION ATTIRE:

Cap and Gown: If you haven't already tried your graduation cap and gown for fit, please do so immediately to make sure they fit properly. Occasionally mistakes have been made. If you wait too long, we will not be able to do anything about improper fit. Hang your gown to allow wrinkles to fall out. Your gown may need light pressing.

Cap: The cap, called a mortarboard, should be worn parallel to the floor, not propped on the back of the head. One of the points is to be worn in the middle of the forehead about two inches above the eye line. The tassel attaches to the button and hangs to your right. The entire group of graduates will move the tassel from right to left after diplomas are conferred.

Senior Ladies: Your personal dress clothing (white/light) should not show above the gown collar or below the gown hem. Wear dark (preferably black) shoes. Please, only small earrings. No necklaces outside of the gown.

Senior Men: Wear dark pants (preferably black), dark shoes, dark socks, dark tie, white shirt with a collar. No bare legs allowed! No flipflops, etc.
