Mark Florence played four years on the Camden Central High School golf team 1981-1984. Mark was offered a 4 year golf scholarship by the University of Tennessee at Martin. Mark was a four-year member of the nationally-ranked golf team which participated in the NCAA Division II National Championships during three of his seasons. Florence served as team captain his senior year. In his final college match, he came on strong to post a 14th place finish in the National Championship in 1989 and lead the UT Martin team to a ninth-place finish. He also was one of 20 players from across the nation selected to play in the East-West match play held in conjunction with the championships. He was inducted into the Athletics Hall of Fame
