Tom Mckelvy

Tom was an outstanding offensive and defensive back for the Camden Lions football team. He was a four year letterman. Tom was one of the leading scorers in the state his senior year with 133 points- and 22 touchdowns. He made the All Volunteer Conference team his junior and senior years and was an All West Tennessee back his senior season. Tom led the Camden Lions to an undefeated season in 1965. He scored four touchdowns in the Volunteer Conference Championship game against Henderson and was Most Valuable player in the Little Cotton Bowl against Brownsville. Tom played college football for UT Martin. He was a four year letterman and helped lead UT Martin to a victory in the 1967 Tangerine Bowl. Tom was a true leader and one of Camden's all time greats.
